
The above named Order made on 28 July 2022 if confirmed as made, will modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding Public Footpath Number 1206 in the parish of Woodhall Spa, commencing at Stixwould Road at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TF 1915 6335 (Point A) and running in a generally west south westerly direction between two properties known as 31 and 33 Stixwould Road for a distance of approximately 89 metres to OSGR TF 1907 6332 (Point B) where it reaches the south-eastern corner of Jubilee Park' cricket ground/playing field. The footpath has a width of 2 metres and a total length of approximately 89 metres and is shown between points A-B on the Order plan referenced 2022/006/DMMO389/A4.
